

Web Services Hosting Requirements

Summary

This document exists to specify the requirements to host UB4/CWP/MMRS along with communication modules, and Mobile Service Orders (MSOs).

Minimum Requirements

minimum requirements	
Server	Hosted: N/A On-Premise: Windows Server OS
Static IP Address	Obtained by Internet Service Provider \$5.00-\$20.00/Monthly
DNS A Record	<yoururl>.com that forwards to static IP address of the billing server</yoururl>
SSL Certificate	Usually Purchased though your domain registar*

^{*}This just lets people know your site is registered and secure. Cannot be self-signed; must either correspond to the A record subdomain or be a wildcard certificate and have the ability to be installed in IIS.

Additional Recommendations

- Local Admin Access CUSI will need local admin rights to your server in order to configure your payment portal and CWP.
- Remote Server Access (optional) Allowing CUSI unattended access to the server can speed up the setup time. We can use our remote connection tool (Bomgar) or your existing tool if applicable.
- Open Firewall ports You will need to allow for traffic over ports 1443 & 42001-42016 for both TCP & UDP. This should be done on both the external firewall and windows firewall of your server. You can also create a whitelist of IP addresses to further reduce the exposure. Please contact CUSI for an updated IP list should you desire.

Definitions

Static IP Address – a unique number assigned to a computer on a network that does not change over time.

DNS A Record – a record used to map a domain or sub-domain (URL) to an IP address.

SSL Certificate – is a data file on your web server that provides security for online communications.
